- Polyurethane exterior decking cleaner

- Extension pole
- Brush (75-100mm)

WHAT IS POLYURETHANE?

Polyurethane is an incredibly resilient, flexible, and durable manufactured resin that is ideal for coating timber surfaces. It provides a protective, hard wearing clear finish to bring out the natural wood grain with a rich, warm appearance on interior timber surfaces. It is easy to apply and protects and seals the surface.



Top Tip

BRUSHING

Avoid overbrushing and use long strokes to lay off and brush out as many bubbles as possible.

Any remaining bubbles will typically disappear after application.

Top Tip

BRUSHING

- When brushing, finish by laying off in the direction of the timber grain.
- Take care when applying on vertical surfaces as drips or runs may occur.
- Lightly sand between 1st and 2nd coats with a 240-400 grit paper.
- Ensure the product does not aerate, this will create bubbles in the finish.

Pascol Decking Oil is an easy to use penetrating oil designed to protect and enhance the natural beauty of exterior timber. It has been formulated to highlight the timber grain and produce a natural timber-look finish.

Pascol Decking Oil contains fungicide to provide protection against discolouration caused by mould and mildew and resists UV damage. It also contains wax for durability and water repellency.



Top Tip

Apply two coats with a clean, good quality paint brush, flat applicator pad or spray.

To avoid lap-marks always apply along the full lengths of timber, working your way across the deck.

Always work in shaded areas during the hottest part of the day.
